Greetings from Village Hall -

February 28, 2022

I want to give a quick update on some of the activities here in Stillman Valley. As was explained in a past letter, we have had a partial collapse in our storm water ditch. An engineering study revealed several recommendations. One recommendation is to develop some retention ponds to slow the water run off rates.

With that goal in mind, the Village of Stillman Valley has purchased the house at 221 South Pine Street with plans to demolish the home and construct the recommended dry retention pond. This pond will work very much like the one by the Fire Station or by Meridian Road and Pershing. Water will NOT be standing in this pond except during heavy rain events.

There are no immediate confirmed or scheduled plans at this time. As new and additional information is available, we will pass it along.

I have another topic to share at this time. Per the terms of the contract between Moring Disposal and the Village of Stillman Valley, there will be a 2.5% increase in the monthly per home refuse collection rate to become effective 5-1-2022. This would take the rate from \$13.90 to \$14.24 per month per home. Seniors will be at the rate from \$12.52 to \$12.83. This increase will appear on your May bill that you will receive in the early part of June.
